Re: Alpha Radiation Contamination at Bruce Nuclear Plant

As you are no doubt aware, there was a significant number of Boilermakers nationwide affected by this issue. Testing of members who have worked on this Project is ongoing; however there are significant delays in getting results back from the lab resulting in an 8 to 10 week delay in getting results. Going forward, an onsite Committee consisting of Labour, Contractor and Owner Management has been formed to determine how many people may have had potential uptakes of alpha radiation since the beginning of the Project in 2005. Once those people have been identified, arrangements will be made to have people tested so that a radiation dose assignment can be made and entered into the National Dose Registry in Ottawa.

Local 128 has appointed Brother Rory McDonald as the Boilermaker Representative on this Committee. If any members have worked on the Bruce Restart Project since 2005, we are asking that they contact Brother McDonald and have their name and Employer entered into our database so that we may cross reference our records with Bruce Power's and insure that every member who requires testing receives it.

Brother McDonald is available every Friday from 8am until 2pm (EST). We encourage all members who may have been affected to contact him at their convenience.
