Notice of Nomination and Election of Delegates to the Thirty-Second Consolidated Convention

Members nominated must be present to accept the nomination unless prevented by official union duties, sickness or some other unavoidable circumstances; provided, that in the case of such absence, the Member desiring to be nominated shall notify the Local Lodge in writing prior to the convening of the special nominated meeting that he/she is familiar with and in compliance with all eligibility requirements and will accept if nominated.

As provided in our International Constitution, any Member who has paid dues through January 2011 and prior to 4:30 pm on March 1, 2011 is in good standing and eligible to nominate and run for convention delegate (unless otherwise prohibited). Nominators and candidates should refer to Articles 2 and 28 of the International Constitution for other eligibility requirements.


The provision in the Local Lodge By-Laws and Brotherhoods Constitution regarding Membership meeting attendance requirements has been waived by the International Executive Council in order to assure that Members in good standing are not "unreasonably" denied the right to be nominated and/or elected as delegates to the forthcoming convention.

Election of Convention Delegates


The election of convention delegates for Local Lodge 359 will be **conducted by all-mail ballot** as approved by International President Newton B. Jones. Ballots will be mailed to each Members last known address immediately following the Special Called Nomination Meeting of March 02, 2011. Election ballots must be returned to the Union post office box no later than 10:00 am on April 6, 2011.

Any Member who has paid dues through February 2011 and prior to 4:30 pm on April 1, 2011 will be eligible to vote. Candidates who are not elected as delegates will be alternates with the non-elected candidate who receives the greatest number of votes being the first alternate. The remaining candidates will be ranked in the order of their votes.
