- AHC representative to the Equity Working Group;
- Supervision of Grievance Procedure & Protocol.

The Business Representative shall represent the Council and members in matters pertaining to agreements, complaints, disputes, jurisdiction and organization. You possess excellent communication skills, both oral and written. You have sound problem solving and are familiar working in a union environment. You should be familiar with the unionized construction industry and power projects in BC, including legislation governing the industry.
