**MATT BAKKER SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

**The Quality Control Council of Canada**

This is to announce that the Scholarship Award will be offered again this year.

The rules established initially are still in force. That is, the Matt Bakker Scholarship Award of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.000) will be disbursed in two scholarships of two thousand, five hundred dollars ((\$2,500.00) each.

The recipients of the Scholarship Award(s) shall be limited to a son, daughter, legally adopted child or dependent (during high school years) of a member in good standing, engaged in the NDT Industry from any of the Local Unions or Lodges affiliated with the Quality Control Council of Canada.

The Council has adopted rules to administer the Scholarship Award(s) as follows:

- Applications are limited to high school seniors who will be entering their first year of a two-year or four-year program of academic study at a degree granting, accredited college or university in the fall.
- The award(s) is for one year only being the student's first year of college or university.
- Application for Local Union or Lodge Scholarship Award(s) must be sent directly to the office of the Secretary of the Quality Control Council of Canada by June 30<sup>th</sup> each year. A winner will be selected from among the applicants by the Scholarship Committee no later than July 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Applicants must submit a 600 word essay in regard to "What You Believe The NDT Technicians Gained By Organizing Into Unions 30 Years Ago".
- The Quality Control Council of Canada Scholarship Committee shall consist of Table Officers and Life Members who are available at the time that a meeting for the purpose of making selections is called.

- The Scholarship Award(s) winners will be selected by the Committee on the basis of such other factors as academic achievement, career goals, extra curricular activities and school activities, which should be included along with the essay. In the event that the Committee is unable to select a winner by consensus, the finalist(s) will be requested to submit a further written essay on a subject determined by the Scholarship Committee.
- The selection of the Scholarship Award(s) winner(s) by the Committee is final and binding.
- The Award will be transmitted by the Secretary of the Quality Control Council of Canada directly to the financial aid office of the college or university which the winner(s) will attend.
- In the event that an Award(s) winner, in any year, does not actually enter college or university in the fall, for whatever reason, that scholarship will not be granted for such year.
