**Notice of Nomination and Election of Delegates
to the Thirty-Fourth Consolidated Convention**

Re: Nomination of Candidates for Local Lodge 359 Delegates to the virtual July 2021 Thirty-Fourth Consolidated Convention of the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers. Due to Covid-19, and with approval of International President Newton B. Jones, **nominations will be conducted by an all-mail ballot:**

Date and Time:

- **Nomination ballots must be received at the Union Election Committee PO Box on or before 10:00 am of March 10, 2021.**
- **The Nomination and Election Committee will confirm Member eligibility and approve Nominees on March 10, 2021.**

Members nominated must accept the nomination in writing. Due to the all-mail ballot, the Election Committee shall contact all those nominated to confirm and receive the Nominee's acceptance and eligibility in writing.

As provided in our International Constitution, any Member who has paid dues through January 2021 prior to 4:30 pm on March 1, 2021 is in good standing and eligible to nominate and run for convention delegate (unless otherwise prohibited). Nominators and Candidates should refer to Articles 2 and 25 of the International Constitution for other eligibility requirements.

The provision in the Local Lodge By-Laws and Brotherhoods Constitution regarding Membership meeting attendance requirements has been waived by the International Executive Council in order to assure that Members in good standing are not "unreasonably" denied the right to be nominated and/or elected as Delegates to the forthcoming convention.

Election of Convention Delegates

The election of Convention Delegates for Local Lodge 359 will be conducted by all-mail ballot as approved by International President Newton B. Jones. Ballots will be mailed to each Members' last known address immediately after the receipt of the nomination ballots and confirmation of eligibility by the Election Committee on March 10, 2021.

Date and Time:

- **Election ballots must be returned to the Union Post Office Box no later than 10:00 am on April 7, 2021.**

Any Member who has paid dues through February 2021 prior to 4:30 pm on April 1, 2021 will be eligible to vote. Candidates who are not elected as Delegates will be Alternates. The Non-elected Candidate who receives the greatest number of votes will be the first alternate, with the remaining Candidates ranked in the order of their votes.
