Interpretation Bulletin

**Re: Cannabis (THC) Specimen Analysis - Immunalysis Screening and Confirmation Cut-offs and the addition of a test panel under our Policy for Fentanyl**

Due to the legalization of Cannabis (Cannabinoids – THC), the subsequent changes in the Criminal Code related to the use of the substance while in operation of a motor vehicle, and need for the Policy to be relevant for our owner/clients, the Policy Administrative Committee of the Construction Industry of BC Substance Abuse Testing and Treatment Program Policy, has changed both the Initial Test Cut-off Level (ng/ml) and Confirmation Test Cut-off Level (ng/ml) for this drug, when oral fluid testing is used.

It should be noted that the MRO states that anyone using Fentanyl is often using with other substances – heroin, cocaine etc., but that if someone is using a Fentanyl patch they will likely be treated as non-negative and after verification of the prescription ruled as a negative test result with a warning.
